In 2008, the Association then changed its name to the Calgary Royals Athletic Association. Over the years, as the city expanded, the Association's activities grew as well, now sponsoring a variety of age groups. This includes three U13 "AA," three U15 "AAA," one U15 "AAA," one U16 "AA," one U17 "AAA," two U18 "AA," a U18 "AAA," and two Junior "B" teams.




