- Personal written or video essay
 - o Essay is intended to outline how the applicant meets the above criteria
 - Written essays should be no longer than 2 pages
 - Video Essays should be no longer than 2 minutes
- Reference Letters
 - Please provide 2 reference letters
 - One letter should be a non-hockey contact
 - One letter can be a hockey contact
 - Please ensure that when you are submitting a reference letter that the individual providing it has given you a personalized letter (not a 'template' where only names are changed)
