Position Overview:

The Calgary Royals Athletic Association is seeking passionate and dedicated Assistant Coaches to assist Head Coaches. The ideal candidate will possess the ability to train and inspire young elite athletes, ensuring a positive and competitive environment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Take direction from the team's Head Coach and work closely with other Assistant Coaches toward a shared goal of developing all the athletes on the team
- Participate in evaluations and provide position-specific guidance to the Head Coach in selecting athletes to draft to the team
- Develop and implement practice plans as requested by the Head Coach
- Attend and be responsible for position-specific bench management and coaching at all exhibition, league and tournament games throughout the season (September - March).
- Provide individual and team feedback after games to help players to identify areas for improvement on an individual and team level.
- As requested by the Head Coach, participate in game tape review sessions so that
 players can better understand systematic play, build upon their success and mitigate
 areas of weakness.
- Foster a positive and inclusive team culture that encourages participation and passion for the sport through on-ice and off-ice team building activities.
- Collaborate with other coaches, the Manager of Hockey Operations, and the CRAA to ensure a unified approach to training and competition.
- Conduct individual and team assessments to track progress during the season and make adjustments to training as needed to ensure optimal development of individual athletes and competitive level of the team.
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all participants, adhering to all league and organizational guidelines.
- Model Calgary Royals values of teamwork, respect, commitment and integrity in your words and actions, both on and off the ice



- Attend and contribute to team meetings, communicate effectively with players and parents, and maintain a strong presence in the community.
- Attend coaching staff meetings and training sessions as required.
